2023-2024 Community Scholarships

The Chi Zeta Chapter Charter Member Scholarship (\$500)

Given to provide assistance to a student interested in continuing their education beyond high school. This may cover Community College, trade school, College or University tuition, and other fees, as the committee may deem appropriate. One award of \$500 shall be given; a past recipient may apply for renewal.

Recipients shall be:

- 1. At least in the 11th grade and on the road to high school graduation (funds will only be paid after graduation) or have a GED or a high school diploma
- 2. Documentation of community service during high school
- 3. Acceptance to a program for which the funds are needed
- 4. Financial need may be considered

The Lola B. Greer Scholarship (\$250)

Given in recognition of scholastic achievement in math. Two awards of \$250 each shall be given; a past recipient may apply for renewal.

Recipients shall be:

- 1. Oklahoma City High School Student enrolled full time
- 2. Currently in grades 11 or 12
- 3. Have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 and an average grade of A (3.6) or higher in math courses.

Scholarships reserved for members of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority Inc.

The Chi Zeta Chapter Excellence Award

Given to a member of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc. to assist with the cost associated with attending a National Conference. An award of \$600 shall be given to a member who has shown promise and who has rendered excellent service to the community, past recipients may not reapply.

Undergraduate recipients must:

- 1. Be a member of an Undergraduate chapter of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc. in Oklahoma and be in good standing with the sorority and financial on all levels.
- 2. Author an essay about the history of Boule'.
- 3. Attend Boule' the year of the award
- 4. Attend a Chi Zeta Chapter Meeting to discuss the Boule' attended
- 5. Be a full-time undergraduate student

The Mattie Jeltz Undergraduate Scholarship (\$500)

Given to an Undergraduate member of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc. One award of \$500 shall be given; a past recipient may not reapply.

Recipients shall be:

- 1. A full time student in the state of Oklahoma attending an accredited College or University 2. A member of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc. in good standing with the sorority and financial on all levels 3. Have a cumulative grade point average of 3.00
- 4. At least completed 30 credit hours of college
- 5. Applicants must author an essay about Soror Mattie Jeltz

The Anna Elease Moore Graduate Soror Assistance Grant (\$250)

Given to a member of the Chi Zeta Chapter who has completed her undergraduate degree within the last 5 years. This assistance will help a Soror to attend conferences and leadership activities offered by Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc. without the financial barrier. Recipients should report on training and take opportunities to recruit new members. One award of \$250 shall be given.

Recipients:

- Must have completed their undergraduate degree within the last five years
- A member of the Chi Zeta Chapter of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc. in good standing with the sorority and financial on all levels
- Must use funds for Zeta related training, conferences, and/or events
- Must author an essay about Anna Elease Moore and the importance of attending conferences and training
- Must have completed community service with attached documentation
- Financial need may be considered
